Muswellbrook Steptember Community Walk and Family Funday

Hello! I am writing to you to give you a bit of information about an event we are holding on 9th September at Simpson Park in Muswellbrook. The event is in aid of the Cerebral Palsy Alliance's Steptember fundraising campaign and will be the second year we have held this day locally.

By way of background, the Cerebral Palsy Alliance provides therapy services to many families locally who's children are effected by Cerebral Palsy. These services include but aren't limited to, Physiotherapy, Speech Therapy and Occupational therapy. I became involved with the Alliance in 2016 after the birth of my daughter who was diagnosed with CP due to a Stroke in utero (yes that's right – babies can have strokes too!). We commenced therapy with the alliance at 6 weeks of age and haven't looked back. We are hoping to raise funds by holding the Community walk and family funday as a way of giving back to a service that has given us so much.

Until we started working with the Alliance I was unaware that the services provided to children prior to formal diagnosis and funding through the NDIS are supplied by the Alliance free of charge to families and are covered out of fundraising donations.

So, a little about the day! We kick off the day with registrations for the 1.5km walk at 9am and aim to head off at about 10.30am, we aim to be all back and completed by 11.15am – it's a pretty leisurely stroll. Once back at the park there are market stands, a BBQ, entertainment for the kids and raffles. We're all wrapped and done by 3pm.

We encourage walk participants to dress up in Green and Purple to not only help attract a bit of attention but also to be in the running for one of our lucky walker prizes.

If you feel that this is a day your school would like to get involved in I would love to hear from you. Involvement may be as simple as joining us for the walk and having your students "dress up" for the event, having a stall to promote your school or even just by helping to distribute flyers for the event.

This is a brilliant cause, a really great social day and most importantly a service that needs to continue to be provided to our community.
