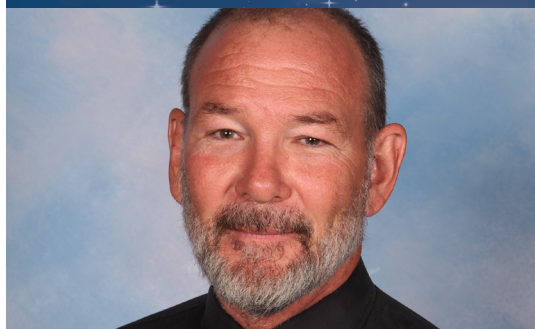

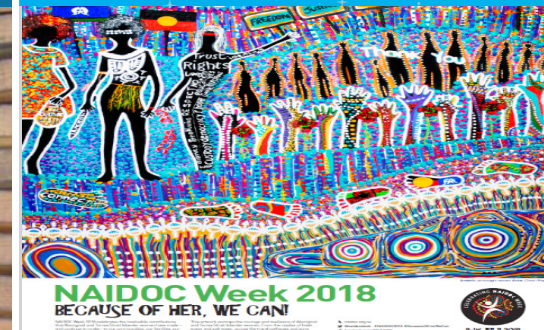

The two hour workshop will offer parents and supervisors hands-on advice on how to provide the most effective driving practice for learner drivers.

- ✓ How the NSW graduated licensing scheme works
- ✓ The importance of learner driver experience
- ✓ Lesson planning and dealing with stress
- ✓ Tips for safe solo driving

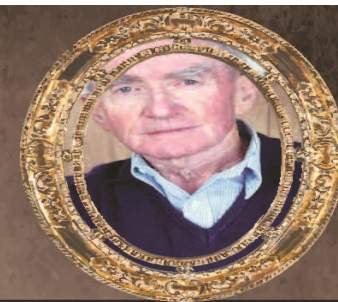
